1. Child protection Policy – presentation by Alan Dean-Lewis. MSA has worked with NSPCC on a policy document to distribute to clubs. From 1 Jan 2007, recognised clubs will have to consider appointing a Child Protection Officer (and will need a good reason not to). The Child Protection Officer will need a CRB check. This requirement will be on the Club registration Form. Training will be offered (probably in early 2007).

2. DEFRA – single payment scheme – new scheme in 2007.

3. Restricted byways – will require written permission from the Highways Authority for RTA section 33 approval.

4. MSA Board - new chairman Alan Gow.

5. Wales Rally GB – agreement from Wales for sponsorship to 2011.
