**2. Minutes of Last Meeting (14 April 2009)/Matters Arising**

The minutes were proposed a true record by Sheffield & Hallamshire MC, seconded by Notts SCC and agreed.

Matters arising:-

On the proposal to amalgamate EMAMC and ANEMMC, the Chairman reported that the proposal had been put to an ANEMMC meeting the Monday following EMAMC's last meeting. The debate concluded in a motion not to pursue the amalgamation which was carried 12 to 2 with 1 abstention. The EMAMC Executive discussed the proposal at their next meeting. The Executive's view is that times are hard and it is difficult to raise the standard of championships/events and attract enough competitors. There was some discussion of the Northern Ireland championship style (where all competitors on championship events are automatically registered for the championship). The Executive will report back to the October Delegates' Meeting.

*Regional Committee met on 24 May*

A. International licences down 1000 on May 2008 figures. Permit numbers 6% down.

B. Regional Timekeepers' List to remain as it is.

1. British GP – Plan B is to return to Silverstone. Cut-off date for decision is September.
2. Rally GB is being underwritten by the MSA
3. Licence fees down 5%, permit income down 10%.
4. Expect 2010 to be harder
5. Go Motorsport – newsletter update shortly
6. Go Karting increase from 16 to 20 venues.
7. Croft Circuit – MSA hoping to mediate an out-of-court settlement.
8. Motorsport Academy Apprenticeship scheme launched (with Croydon College)

10. Insurance – looking at self-insurance, being advised by JLT
11. Blue Book – numbering to change for 2010
12. Training & Development Fund – only 2 applications since February

Sheffield & Hallamshire running at Barkston Heath. There has been a lot of

discussion with the Forestry Commission over works at Twyford Wood. The condition that the FC are imposing make it impossible to do any work there.

Next round: Opposite Lock on Saturday.

Wolds Rally has moved to 30 August from 6 September (forced by availability of venue), Will ask if any competitors object to date change.

48 registrations. Events are thriving. Last round (061) had a full entry. Next round (Drystone) also has a full entry.

Twyford Wood: Howard had a meeting in May with FC and Mike Jones (Sheffield & Hallamshire). In the long term, FC foresee restoring Twyford to natural woodland. In the medium term they don't have a problem with continued use for motorsport.

Repairs are needed for SV events. FC will not do any repairs. In principle they don't mind clubs doing repairs as long as they comply with the Civil Engineer's terms.

These terms don't fit with what has been done in the past. Twyford was used successfully by the Huntsman Enduro Rally.
