

2021 StreetCar Cup Regulations

The 2021 StreetCar Cup is organised by Motorsport UK (the “promoter”). It will run in accordance with the regulations of Motorsport UK (specifically, [section M](#) and [section J](#)) and these series Regulations and the supplementary regulations for each event.

The Cup comprises of a series of **x** regional series, from which the top **2** points scoring drivers, from every class, will progress onto the 2021 British StreetCar Cup Shoot-Out on **[insert date]**.

1. PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 All drivers must have registered for their relevant regional series and hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence (or above).
- 1.2 The table below outlines additional entry requirements for each class

Class	Entry Requirement
Allcomers	Hold a full DVLA car licence & have competed in an Autotest/AutoSOLO before
Newcomer	Hold a full DVLA car licence & have not competed in an Autotest/AutoSOLO before
Junior	Aged 14 - 17 years old Participants must be 17 at time of registration but can continue as a junior if they turn 18 during the year. Must carry a passenger who holds a valid DVLA driving licence, even if they are 17 and hold a DVLA car licence.

2. REGISTRATION

- 2.1 All drivers must register for their regional series in order to score points and compete in their region’s events. Drivers must register online via **[website link]**.
- 2.2 Drivers may register to take part in up to two regional series
- 2.3 Drivers cannot change their nominated region(s) after **[insert date – the date of first event of the year]**

3. ENTRIES

Each regional series event must be entered online through [\[website link\]](#). Entry fees and entry deadline dates will vary across the regional series. Details will be outlined on the respective regional series section of the [StreetCar website](#).

4. Reserved Entries

10 places will be reserved for Junior and Newcomer participants at all events.

6. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Cars must be driven to the event and must comply with section J & M (AutoSOLO).

8. CLASSES

Participants will score points in the class and region(s) they have registered to compete in. The classes are:

Allcomers
Newcomer
Junior

The StreetCar Cup points will be awarded to the fastest overall participants in each of these classes, regardless of any additional class structures that may exist within the regional series (e.g classes for Fwd and Rwd).

9. STREETCAR SERIES POINTS

9.1 Class points will be awarded at every qualifying event, towards the respective regional series, as outlined in the table below.

- 9.2 Junior drivers who turn 18 after registering for the Junior class must remain in this class for the remainder of the season
- 9.3 Final series points will be based on competitor's best 5 results across events in their Region.
- 9.4 Series ties will be resolved using the following criteria and in the following order, using all events entered:
1. In favour of the competitor with the greater number of 1st place scores, then 2nd place scores, etc.
 2. In favour of the higher placed competitor (as per the event final results) on the first event at which all tied competitors were present.
 3. In favour of the higher placed competitor (as per the event final results) who competed on the earliest event in the series.
- 9.5 Interim series results will be posted electronically on the StreetCar Cup website after each event, and provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the last events in each region.
